4. Accounts for Year ended 31.3.22

The end of year accounts was discussed. There was a deficit of £83.76 and the closing cash balance as at 31st March 2022 was £18,608.95. There were committed costs of Traffic Calming £3,722 and legal fees estimate at £2,500 carried over to 22/23. The surplus funds are earmarked for traffic calming schemes.
