A claim had been made through the proper channels, but nothing is happening.</li><li>2. It was felt the quality of resurfacing on the Stewkley Road was poor.</li><li>3. A pothole was repaired last week just outside Orchard Ground entrance. It was the size of a laptop computer whilst there were numerous potholes at the entrance to Silver Street ignored. We had received numerous complaints from residents on the quality of the work.</li><li>4. Repair work should have been completed on Church Path. This was first raised in July 2022.</li><li>5. There is an issue with kerb posts concerning encroachment of council land outside New Dairy Farm which was raised in May 2022.</li><li>6. Roadworks near Acorn Farm took over a week. Why did this work take so long?</li></ol>
